Text of a further amendment, offered by Mr. Straus of Mattapoisett, to the Senate amendment (striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the text contained in Senate document numbered 2486) of the House Bill financing improvements to municipal roads and bridges (House, No. 3903). July 15, 2021.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)

By striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:—

1 "SECTION 1. To provide for a program of transportation development and
2 improvements, the sum set forth in section 2 for the several purposes and subject to the
3 conditions specified in this act, is hereby made available, subject to the laws regulating the
4 disbursement of public funds. The sum made available in this act shall be in addition to any
5 amounts previously appropriated or made available for these purposes.

9 6122-2125 For the construction and reconstruction of municipal ways as described in
10 clause (b) of the second paragraph of section 4 of chapter 6C of the General Laws; provided, that

12 Transportation; provided further, that a city or town may expend, without further appropriation,
13 for these projects amounts not in excess of the amount provided to the city or town under this

14 item upon preliminary notice of such amount, which shall be provided by the department to the
15 city or town not later than March 1 of each year; and provided further, that the commonwealth
16 shall reimburse a city or town under this item, subject to the availability of funds as provided in
17 section 9G of chapter 29 of the General Laws, within 30 days after receipt by the department of a
18 request for reimbursement from the city or town, which request shall include certification by the
19 city or town that actual expenses have been incurred on projects eligible for reimbursement
20 under this item and that the work has been completed to the satisfaction of the city or town
21 according to the specifications of the project and in compliance with applicable laws and
22 procedures established by the department.....\$200,000,000

41 SECTION 9. Section 33 of said chapter 383 is hereby amended by striking out the figure
42 “\$1,970,000,000” and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- \$2,045,000,000.

43 SECTION 10. Section 40 of said chapter 383 is hereby amended by striking out the
44 figure “\$2,190,698,500” and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- \$2,265,698,500.

45 SECTION 11. To meet the expenditures necessary in carrying out section 2, the state
46 treasurer shall, upon request of the governor, issue and sell bonds of the commonwealth in an
47 amount to be specified by the governor from time to time but not exceeding, in the aggregate,
48 \$200,000,000. All bonds issued by the commonwealth as aforesaid shall be designated on their
49 face, Commonwealth Transportation Improvement Act of 2021, and shall be issued for a
50 maximum term of years, not exceeding 30 years, as the governor may recommend to the general
51 court under section 3 of Article LXII of the Amendments to the Constitution. All such bonds
52 shall be payable not later than June 30, 2056, pursuant to said section 3 of said Article LXII. All
53 interest and payments on account of principal on these obligations shall be payable from the
54 General Fund. Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary, bonds issued
55 under this section and interest thereon shall be general obligations of the commonwealth.

56 SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, funds allocated
57 to the commonwealth from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to section 602
58 of Title VI of the federal Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 802, may, consistent with federal
59 requirements and guidance related to spending under said section 602, be used for maintenance
60 or pay-go funded building of transportation infrastructure, including roads."
