An Act establishing residency requirements for the offices of mayor, city council, and school committee in the city of Revere.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. No person shall be eligible for election to the office of mayor, the office of  
2           councillor-at-large or the school committee in the city of Revere unless at the time of such  
3           election the person has been a resident of the city of Revere for at least 1 year preceding.

4           SECTION 2. No person shall be eligible for election to the office of ward councillor in  
5           the city of Revere unless at the time of such election the person has been a resident of the ward  
6           from which election is sought for at least 1 year preceding.

7           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
