An Act relative to the Board of Registration of Cosmetology and Barbering exams.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 87V of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence  
3 the following sentence:- The board shall offer all practical and written examinations in the  
4 following languages: English, Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese and Haitian Creole.

5           SECTION 2. Section 1 shall take effect 180 days after the effective date of this act.
