Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The fourth paragraph of paragraph (h) of subdivision (1) of section 4 of
- 2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
- 3 adding the following sentence:- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 4 members in service of a retirement system eligible for creditable service under this paragraph
- 5 may make application for said creditable service at any time.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 3 of chapter 71 of the acts of 1996, as most recently amended by
- 7 section 2 of chapter 468 of the acts of 2002, is hereby amended by striking out the second and
- 8 third paragraphs.
