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**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**  
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An Act establishing a select board in the town of Bolton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive  
2 body of the town of Bolton, previously known as the board of selectmen, shall be known as the  
3 select board and shall have the powers and authority of a board of selectmen under any general  
4 or special law, bylaw of the town or rules and regulations applicable thereto.

5           SECTION 2. Notwithstanding chapters 40 and 40A of the General Laws, the attorney  
6 general may approve amendments to the zoning by-law of the town of Bolton approved pursuant  
7 to article 10 at the annual town meeting of the town of Bolton held on May 3, 2021.

8           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
