An Act to change the number of members of the Insurance Advisory Committee for the town of Milford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the  
2           contrary, and in particular notwithstanding the provisions of G.L. c. 32B, § 3 for an insurance  
3           advisory committee comprised of eight members, the Town of Milford shall have an insurance  
4           advisory committee comprised of nine members, as follows: seven persons to be duly elected or  
5           appointed to membership on such committee by organizations of the employees affected, one  
6           person who shall be a retiree of a governmental unit who shall be duly appointed to membership  
7           on said committee by the appropriate public authority, and one member who shall be a non-union  
8           employee of the Town who shall be duly elected or appointed to membership on such committee  
9           by the affected non-union employees of the Town;

10          SECTION 2: This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
