An Act relative to police detail work in the town of Hudson.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a police officer  
2 who has served at least 20 years of continuous, full-time service in the police department of the  
3 town of Hudson who terminated the service in good standing and retired based on  
4 superannuation may be appointed as a special police officer and may work police details within  
5 the town of Hudson until the age of 70; provided, however, that any such officer so appointed  
6 shall abide by the rules and regulations promulgated by the police department, including firearm  
7 qualification and cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)/automated external defibrillator (AED)  
8 and first responder training.

9           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
