**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act establishing a voting precinct in the town of Hingham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, precinct 7 of the
2 Town of Hingham shall be 1 precinct for the purpose of forming congressional, representative,
3 senatorial, or councilor districts but shall have 2 polling places for the purposes of voting in a
4 state or municipal election: 1 polling location shall be located in the Linden Ponds retirement
5 community at 203 Linden Ponds Way, to serve voters residing within Linden Ponds located in
6 the Town of Hingham and shall be known as precinct 7A, and the other polling location shall be
7 designated by the Select Board under section 24 of chapter 54 of the General Laws to serve all
8 others in current precinct 7 which shall be known as precinct 7.

9 SECTION 2. The board of registrars of voters and the town clerk shall divide precinct 7
10 into precincts 7 and 7A as set forth in SECTION 1, and only the names of voters who reside in
11 each shall appear on the voting list for any such precinct.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
