In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act protecting public higher education student information.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 66 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is amended by
- 2 inserting the following new section:
- 3 Section 22: Public colleges and universities as defined in Section 5 of Chapter 15A shall
- 4 not be required to produce records defined as education records in the Family Education Rights
- 5 and Privacy Act (20 USC 11232g) at 34 CFR § 99.3, including those education records
- 6 designated by the public colleges and universities as directory information as defined in FERPA
- 7 at 34 CFR § 99.3. This section shall not apply to requests from federal, state, or municipal
- 8 agencies.
