**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act to promote alcohol storage space.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of Chapter 138 as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended
2 by inserting after line 37 the following:

3 An establishment licensed under section fifteen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight
4 and is defined as a food store by Chapter 94, section 184B, is hereby permitted under this section
5 to store its licensed alcoholic beverages in a licensed and bonded warehouse. Said licensee shall
6 only be permitted to use the hereinabove described stored licensed alcoholic beverages on such
7 licensee's premises in the normal course of business and such licensed alcoholic beverages shall
8 not be for resale to other establishments licensed under this chapter.
