An Act relative to the closure of the Saugus ash landfill.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department  
2 of environmental protection shall initiate the closure process as described in 310 CMR 19.00 for  
3 the ash landfill located at 100 Salem Turnpike in the Town of Saugus no later than December 31,  
4 2026.
