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In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)  
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An Act removing the residency requirement for the board of trustees of the Grand Army Building in the city of Lynn.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The fifth sentence of section 4 of chapter 220 of the acts of 1919 is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the following words:- and has been a resident of the city of Lynn for at  
3 least five consecutive years preceding his appointment.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
