**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to Chapter 26 of the Acts of 2021.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1:

2 Chapter 26 of the Acts of 2021 is hereby amended by replacing subparagraph (e) thereof
3 of Section 1 by the following:-

4 (e) One of the licenses granted under this act shall be issued within 1 year after January
5 30, 2023 and the second license granted under this act shall be issued within 2 years after
6 January 30, 2023; provided, however, that a license originally granted within that time period
7 may be granted to a new applicant under subsection (c) or (d) any time thereafter.
