In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act authorizing the town of Pepperell to convey a certain parcel of land to the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and pursuant to Article 97 of the Amendments to the Constitution, the town of Pepperell, acting by and
- 3 through its board of selectmen and conservation commission, may convey a certain parcel of
- 4 land in the town of Pepperell to the commonwealth, acting by the department of fish and game,
- 5 including consent to a taking of land by the commonwealth, to be held for conservation purposes
- 6 in connection with the department of fish and game's Unkety Brook wildlife management area,
- 7 for consideration of \$4,300. The parcel is further described in a deed recorded in the Middlesex
- 8 South registry of deeds in book 75910, page 75 on October 16, 2020 and was acquired for the
- 9 promotion and development of natural resources and the protection of watershed resources of the
- 10 town.
- 11 (b) The land to be conveyed pursuant to subsection (a) is shown as Lot 3 on a plan of
- land entitled "Plan of Land in Pepperell, MA, Lowell Road, Pepperell, MA" dated July 30, 1986,

- prepared by H-Star Engineering, and recorded in the Middlesex South registry of deeds as book
- 14 1986, page 1092 on August 13, 1986.
- SECTION 2. The town of Pepperell shall bear all costs, if any, for the transaction
- 16 authorized in this act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
