An Act authorizing the town of Wellesley to grant certain licenses for the temporary sale of alcoholic beverages.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 635 of the Acts of 1982 is hereby amended by  
2     inserting before the last clause in the paragraph, the following: "and, pursuant to Section 14 of  
3     Chapter 138, special temporary licenses to the responsible manager of any indoor or outdoor  
4     activity or enterprise for the sale of wine and malt beverages only".

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
