An Act relative to certain voting precincts in the city of Quincy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Census Blocks
2 250214180021006, 250214180021007, 250214180021008, 250214180022000,
3 250214180023000, 250214180023001, 250214180023002, 250214180023003,
4 250214180023004, 250214180023005, 250214180023006, 250214180023012, in the City of
5 Quincy shall be moved from Ward 5 Precinct 1 to Ward 2 Precinct 5 and Census Blocks
6 250214177033024, 250214179022003, 250214179022004, 250214179022005,
7 250214179022006, 250214179022007, 250214179022008 in the City of Quincy shall be moved
8 from Ward 2 Precinct 5 to Ward 5 Precinct 1A.

9 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, section 1 shall
10 remain in effect until the drawing of new precincts after the 2030 Federal Census in accordance
11 with Section 1 of Chapter 54 of the General Laws.

12 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
