Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Census Blocks

- 7 250214179022006, 250214179022007, 250214179022008 in the City of Quincy shall be moved
- 8 from Ward 2 Precinct 5 to Ward 5 Precinct 1A.
- 9 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, section 1 shall
- remain in effect until the drawing of new precincts after the 2030 Federal Census in accordance
- with Section 1 of Chapter 54 of the General Laws.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
