An Act exempting all future members of police department of the town of Great Barrington from the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all future  
2 members of the police department of the town of Great Barrington shall be exempt from chapter  
3 31 of the General Laws.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall not impair the civil service status of a person holding a  
5 position described in section 1 on the effective date of this act.

6           SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2, no appointments or  
7 promotions made after the effective date of this act will be governed in any way by chapter 31 of  
8 the General Laws.

9           SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
