An Act to continue providing for virtual notarization to address challenges related to COVID-19.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 71 of the acts of 2020 is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after the word “emergency” the following words:- or July 31, 2022 whichever is later.
