An Act relative to the preparation of street lists by registrars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "year," in line 5, the following  
3 words:- ; provided, however, that the lists shall not include the dates of birth or occupations of  
4 said persons.

5           SECTION 2. Section 7 of said chapter 51, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
6 out, in lines 6 to 10, inclusive, the words "name, date of birth, occupation and nationality if not a  
7 citizen of the United States, of every person who is listed under section four, and his residence  
8 on January first of the preceding year and of the current year" and inserting in place thereof the  
9 following words:- : (1) name; (2) residence on January first of the preceding year; and of the  
10 current year and (3) nationality, if not a citizen of the United States, of every person who is listed  
11 pursuant to section 4.
