An Act providing for tenant member appointment to the board of the Needham Housing Authority.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 403 of the acts of 1971 is hereby amended by deleting from Section
2 19, as most recently amended by section 1 of Chapter 341 of the acts of 2018, subsection (viii)
3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

4 (viii) Three (3) members of the Needham Housing Authority for 5-year terms;

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 403 of the acts of 1971 is hereby amended by striking out Section
6 20(b), as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 341 of the acts of 2018, and inserting in
7 place thereof the following:

8 (b) The select board shall appoint a town counsel, members of the board of appeals,
9 election officers, registrars of voters, except the town clerk, members of the historic commission,
10 conservation commission, commission on disabilities, the tenant member of the housing

11 authority and, except as provided in section 19, all other boards, committees and commissions
12 for whom no other method of selection is provided in this charter or by-law.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
