1            *Ordered,* That the committee on Tourism, Arts and Cultural Development be authorized  
2 to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of House  
3 documents numbered 3374, 3381, 3384 and 3388, relative to artists, national heritage areas, and  
4 tourism.

5            Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
8 on or before December 31, 2022.
