In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to the maximum age requirement for original appointment as a police officer in the town of Dedham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 58 and 58A or any general or special law or rule
- 2 or regulation to the contrary regulating the maximum age of an applicant for original
- 3 appointment as police officer, Jonathan Dillon shall be allowed to have his civil service test
- 4 results considered by the town of Dedham for appointment to the position of police officer and,
- 5 if he meets all other requirements, he shall be eligible for certification and appointment to the
- 6 police department of the town of Dedham.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage or take any other action relative
- 8 thereto.
