# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act to provide direct investment for job creation and business expansion in rural communities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following subsection

| 3  | (o.)The secretary of housing and economic development shall, in consultation with the             |
