## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

An Act incorporating the public health lessons learned from the Fukushima nuclear disaster.

- SECTION 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Public Health shall commission a study on the Commonwealth's state of preparedness for a nuclear emergency. The study shall include, but not be limited to:

  1. the department's preparedness and capability to respond to a nuclear emergency
- 1. the department's preparedness and capability to respond to a nuclear emergency
- 2. the locations and current inventory of stockpiled thyroid-protecting agents in nuclear
   power plant areas, as defined in Section 2B of Chapter 639 of the Acts of 1950.
- 7 3. the suitability of the current nuclear monitoring station network
- 4. current best practices regarding radiation monitoring and emergency preparedness for a
   nuclear emergency
- SECTION 2. The department shall provide the full findings of the study, including any legislative recommendations, to the Joint Committee on Public Health, the House Committee on
