Subparagraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as

appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the fourth sentence and

inserting in place thereof the following sentence:-

4 A member who entered service on or before April, 2, 2012 and seeks Group 2 or Group 4

classification and is no longer a public employee at the time of the member's retirement shall be

classified based on the position from which the member was last employed; provided that said

member who entered service on or before April 2, 2102 and who is no longer a public employee

8 at the time of the member's retirement and who has served in more than 1 group may elect to

receive a retirement allowance consisting of pro-rated benefits based upon the percentage of total

years of service that the member rendered in each group.
