An Act relating to the retirement classification of certain employees of the town of Belmont.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32  
2 of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, employees of the town of  
3 Belmont employed as public safety communications dispatchers, supervisors or operations  
4 managers who were hired on or before January 1, 2022 shall be classified by the Belmont  
5 retirement board in Group 2.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
