## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Molly Shahvari.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 Office of Medicaid shall establish a sick leave bank for Molly Shahvari, an employee of the
- 3 Office of Medicaid. Any employee of the Office of Medicaid may voluntarily contribute 1 or
- 4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Molly Shahvari. Sick leave
- 5 bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
- 6 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the office. Whenever Molly Shahvari
- 7 terminates employment with the office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining
- 8 time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
