An Act establishing a sick leave bank for John Carlson, an employee of the Department of State Police.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Department of State Police shall establish a sick leave bank for John Carlson, an employee of the  
3 Department of State Police. Any employee of the Department may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by John Carlson. Sick leave  
5 bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the  
6 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department. Whenever John Carlson  
7 terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any  
8 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
