## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Christopher King, an employee of the department of public health.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of public health, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of public  
2 health shall establish a sick leave bank for Christopher King, an employee of the department of  
3 public health. Any employee of the department of public health may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4 more sick, personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Christopher King. If  
5 Christopher King terminates employment with the department of public health or requests to  
6 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
7 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
9 the department of public health.
