An Act relative to school counselors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the  
2 Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) shall oversee a school counselors  
3 pilot program in Gateway Municipalities, as defined in Chapter 23A Section 3A, that adheres to  
4 the Massachusetts Model for Comprehensive School Counseling Programs that ensures all pre-K  
5 to grade 12 students will receive school counseling services from licensed school counselors.  
6 The school counselor pilot program shall provide one (1) school counselor for a maximum of  
7 two hundred fifty (250) students in participating pilot programs.
