The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to school counselors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the
- 2 Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) shall oversee a school counselors
- 3 pilot program in Gateway Municipalities, as defined in Chapter 23A Section 3A, that adheres to
- 4 the Massachusetts Model for Comprehensive School Counseling Programs that ensures all pre-K
- 5 to grade 12 students will receive school counseling services from licensed school counselors.
- 6 The school counselor pilot program shall provide one (1) school counselor for a maximum of
- 7 two hundred fifty (250) students in participating pilot programs.
