**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court

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An Act relative to science curriculum standards.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1D of Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, in line 31,  
2 after the word "States" the following:-

3           The standards for the subject of science shall include only peer-reviewed and age-  
4 appropriate subject matter; provided, (1) peer-reviewed subject matter shall be defined as  
5 conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods; and (2) age-appropriate shall be  
6 defined as topics, messages, and teaching methods suitable to particular ages or age groups of  
7 children and adolescents, based on developing cognitive, emotional, and behavioral capacity  
8 typical for the age or age group.
