An Act relative to voter harvesting.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 91B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in subsection (c), by striking out, in lines 24 through 28, the  
3 following words:- “; provided, however, that if permitted in the sole discretion of the city or  
4 town clerk, a person designated in writing by the voter and who is not a candidate for an office at  
5 the election, may instead perform the functions of an elected official”.
