An Act relative to discounted MBTA passes for nonprofit entities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (e) of section 5 of chapter 161A of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following
3 sentence:- The board shall not establish a fare in excess of one-half the regular adult cash fare for
4 charitable corporation constituting a public charity organized pursuant to chapter 180 or a
5 nonprofit or charitable organization or an individual branch or division of a nonprofit or
6 charitable organization exempt from taxation under section 501(c)3 of the federal Internal
7 Revenue Code.
