An Act relative to monthly minimum reliability contributions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 139 of chapter 164 of the General Laws of 2018 is hereby amended
- 2 by striking the first sentence of the third paragraph of subsection (i) and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following:-
- 4 The department shall exempt from any monthly minimum reliability contribution the
- 5 following: municipal ratepayers, low-income ratepayers, community solar ratepayers, and
- 6 owners of small-scale solar projects of 25 kilowatts or less.
