Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in lines 19 to 20, the following words: “of
3 patients or prisoners in the employee’s custody”
