In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)

An Act relative to National Heritage Areas.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 272 of the acts of 2010 is hereby amended by inserting after section 2, the
2 following section:-

3 Section 2A. Any National Heritage Area in this state designated by the United States
4 Congress after August 9, 2010, shall be recognized by the commonwealth in the same manner
5 and subject to the same terms, conditions, and limitations, for named areas under this act;
6 provided that each later designated National Heritage Area shall meet all the criteria for
7 recognition as set forth under section 2.
