### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to expanding relief to new businesses established during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general provisions or special laws to the contrary,
- 2 owners of new businesses shall be eligible to receive state unemployment benefits in the event of
- a declared state of emergency. Any individual collecting unemployment benefits, as permitted by
- 4 this act, shall provide to the department of unemployment assistance proof of their intent to open
- 5 their new business immediately, prior to, or during a declared state of emergency. For the
- 6 purpose of this act, the term, "new business", shall mean any business that an owner intended to
- 7 open immediately prior to, or during, a declared state of emergency. The department of
- 8 unemployment assistance shall determine what documentation shall be required as proof of
- 9 intent to open a new business.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
