The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to athletic training.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 23A of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out the definitions of "Athletic Trainer" and "Athletic Training" and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following new definitions: -
- 4 "Athletic Trainer", a person who is duly licensed to practice Athletic Training in the
- 5 Commonwealth in accordance with section 23B.
- 6 "Athletic Training", the application of principles, methods and procedures of evaluation
- 7 and treatment of injuries and other medical conditions of the patient consistent with the
- 8 educational standard and role delineation of the athletic trainer through the use of appropriate
- 9 preventative, emergent, and rehabilitative care, supportive devices, splinting, bracing, and
- physical modalities, including but not limited to heat, cold, massage, water, electric stimulation,

- sound, exercise and exercise equipment in consultation with physicians or dentists duly
- 12 registered in the Commonwealth. Athletic training includes education and instruction to coaches,
- 13 athletes, parents, other medical personnel and the community in the area of care and prevention
- of injuries and other medical conditions.
- SECTION 2. The Board of Allied Health Professions must review and update the rules
- and regulations pursuant to this act within 180 days of the passage of this act.
