An Act authorizing the town of Athol to grant 6 additional liquor licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2           licensing authority of the town of Athol may grant up to 6 additional licenses for a total of 20  
3           licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages or wines and malt beverages to be drunk on the  
4           premises pursuant to section 12 of said chapter 138. A license granted pursuant to this act shall  
5           be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
