An Act requiring creditable service for Massachusetts National Guard service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out, in lines 145 to 150, the words "Notwithstanding the provisions  
3 of this chapter or any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, a member in  
4 service of a retirement system as defined in section one who is a veteran who served in the armed  
5 forces of the United States shall be entitled to credit for active service in the armed services of  
6 the United States" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- Notwithstanding the  
7 provisions of this chapter or any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, a  
8 member in service of a retirement system as defined in section 1 who is a veteran who served in  
9 the armed forces of the United States or a member of the Massachusetts National Guard who is a  
10 member in service of the state employees' retirement system shall be entitled to creditable

- 11 service time for active service in the armed services of the United States or service in the
- 12 Massachusetts National Guard.
