An Act relative to expanding 529 deductions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subparagraph (19) of paragraph (a) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the general  
2 laws, as appearing in the 2018 official edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words:-  
3 “established by the commonwealth or an instrumentality or authority of the commonwealth” and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following:- “established by the commonwealth or any authority  
5 authorized under U.S.C. 529”
