**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act authorizing the town of Clinton to grant additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2   licensing authority of the town of Clinton may grant 6 additional licenses for the sale of all  
3   alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 12 of said chapter 138. Said  
4   licenses shall be subject to all of said chapter 138, except said section 17.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
