An Act authorizing special police officers in the town of Natick to serve until the age of 70.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 93 of the Acts of 2008 is hereby amended by striking
2 the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: Special police officers
3 appointed pursuant to this act shall not be subject to the maximum age restriction applied to
4 regular police officers pursuant to Chapter 32 of the General Laws; provided, however, that a
5 special police officer appointed pursuant to this act shall not be eligible to serve after the last day
6 of the month in which the officer reaches the age of 70.

7 SECTION 2. Section 8 of Chapter 93 of the Acts of 2008 is hereby amended by striking
8 the fourth and fifth sentences and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: Payment
9 pursuant to said section 111F of said chapter 41 shall terminate not later than the last day of the
10 month in which the officer reaches the age of 70.
