An Act authorizing the city of Brockton to grant additional wine and malt beverage licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, or any other general or
- 2 special law to the contrary, the licensing authority of the city of Brockton may grant not more
- 3 than 5 additional licenses for the sale of wine and malt beverages to be drunk off premises in
- 4 addition to the number of licenses ordinarily authorized by law.
