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**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**  
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An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Paula Haley, an employee of the Department of Public Health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Department of Public Health shall establish a sick leave bank for Paula Haley, an employee of  
3 the Department of Public Health. Any employee of the Department of Public Health may  
4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by  
5 Paula Haley. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or  
6 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the  
7 department. Whenever Paula Haley terminates employment with the department or requests to  
8 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the  
9 extended illness leave bank.
