This is a submission of our thirty second request for expenditure from the County Registers' Technological Fund for the Plymouth County Registry of Deeds, and a request for a referral of this plan to the Committees on Ways and Means and Post Audit and Oversight.

Consistent with the provisions of Section 4 of Chapter 4 of the Acts of 2003 and M.G.L. Chapter 29, §2KKK, the proposed expenditures are for purposes of technological improvements at the Plymouth County Registry of Deeds utilizing systems interoperable with other like systems used by other registries.
