An Act requiring warning devices in the event of over pressurized gas entering a home.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 commonwealth or any affiliate of such company shall install an overpressure safety valve and an

3 alert to all customers in the event of an overpressure failure event of natural gas supplied to a

4 residential dwelling.

5 (b) The alert and safety valve shall be installed after a pressure regulator and shall be

6 installed in an outdoor space and shall, upon the failure event, safely release natural gas into the

7 atmosphere.

- 8 (C) The alert shall include an alarm equipped with a voice alert warning occupants to 9 evacuate and call 911, a siren and strobe lights. The voice alert and siren shall be no less than 85 10 decibels in volume.
- SECTION 2. The department of public utilities shall promulgate rules and regulations for
  the implementation of this act not later than 180 days after its enactment.
