By Representative Durant of Spencer and Senator Fattman, a joint petition (subject to Joint Rule 7B) of Peter J. Durant and Ryan C. Fattman that the town of Charlton to be authorized to exempt the police department of said town from certain provisions of the civil service law. Public Service.

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act to remove the town of Charlton Police Department from civil service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all police
2 officers, regardless of rank, in the Town of Charlton police department shall be exempt from the
3 provisions of Chapter 31 of the General Laws.

4 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall not impair the civil service status of any person
5 employed on a permanent basis as a police officer, regardless of rank, of the Town of Charlton
6 Police Department on the effective date of this act.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
